With your support, ICS helps struggling Pima County residents in small but significant ways:

A woman called ICS on a recent Monday morning because her husband had taken off with her purse, all her money and her IDs and credit cards. She and her three children had had nothing to eat since Thursday. She came to the ICS office and got food from our Food Bank and help getting a new driver's license.

A construction worker lost his job after he broke his leg. The months he spent recovering took a toll on his savings. When he was ready to return to work, he had a job offer but needed funds to buy work boots and get a drug test. ICS came through with the \$50 he needed to get back to work.

An elderly woman living alone in her home gets a call every day from an ICS volunteer checking on her welfare. "Couldn't do without your voices in the morning knowing some people care," she said.

The demand for ICS services has increased dramatically in these tough economic times. More seniors, disabled persons and families in financial crisis are turning to us for assistance even as local governments and other funding sources are cutting their support.
