
Dear Father Kitagawa,

On behalf of the Board, staff, and volunteers, I want to express our sincere gratitude for your generous gift of 750.00, to Primavera. For over 25 years caring people like you, through gifts like this, have provided critical programs and advocacy for the more than 20,000 men, women and children who find themselves homeless in our community each year.

You are making a difference. Your investment in Primavera—each gift of time and money—helps bring positive solutions to the challenges of homelessness and poverty. Whether the need is clean clothing and shoes, a warm, safe place to sleep, an affordable place to live, a stable job, or the realized dream of buying a first home, Primavera is there.

An estimated 4,200 homeless people make camp on our streets and deserts on any given night according to the Arizona Department of Economic Security. The causes of homelessness are complex and frightening: an illness and mounting hospital bills bankrupts a family; a youth 'ages out' of foster care; a single mother loses her job; a family is evicted because a father who works full time still can't afford the rent; a young veteran suffers from mental illness; or another traumatic experience forces thousands into homelessness in our community.
